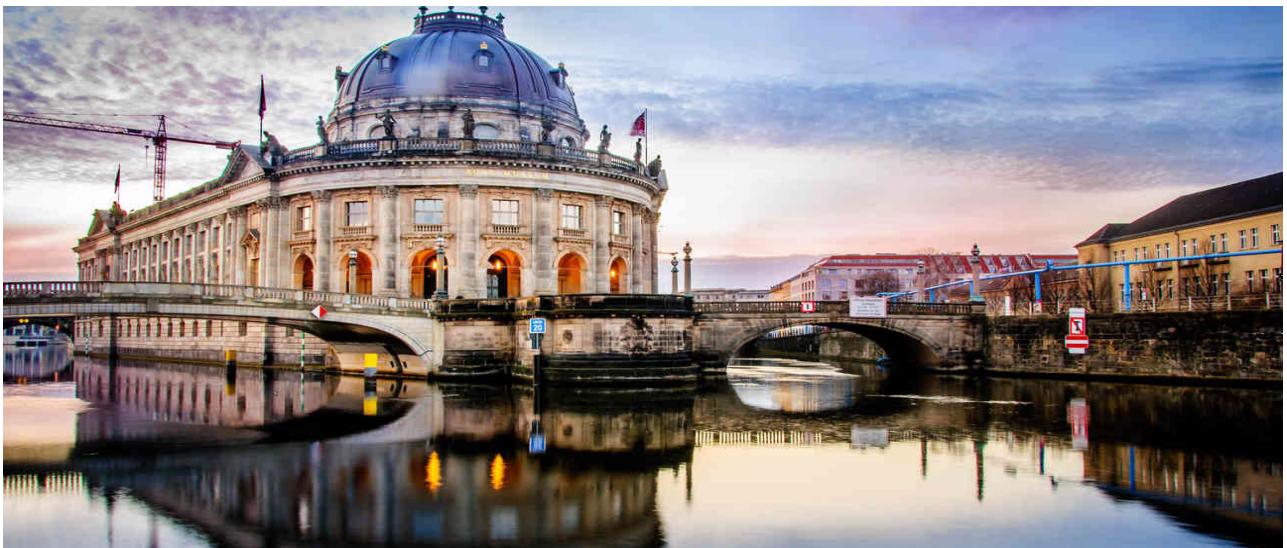
Welcome

Transportation

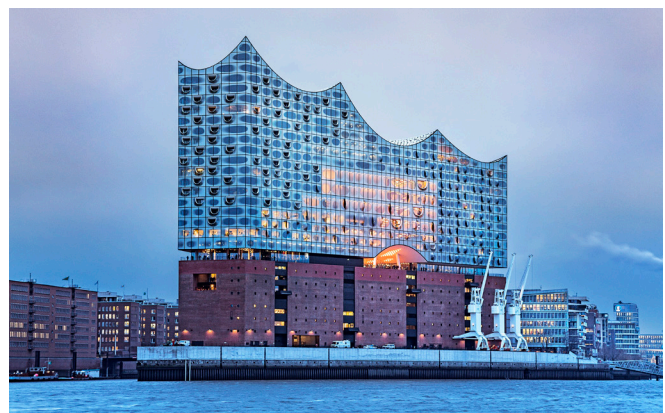
SprachAcademy Berlin provides transportation from the airport to the summer school centre and from the centre to the airport by comfortable minibuses and buses.
